Students can complete the **Child Development Associate** program using one or more of the following delivery formats:

- Traditional on-campus classes
- Online classes
- Interactive video classes

Through online instruction, students anywhere can enroll and complete the program from any location. DCB students have the option of taking collaborative classes from other campuses in the ND University System, giving them many courses from which to select. DCB administers the registration, financial aid, billing, and transcripts for students using this option.

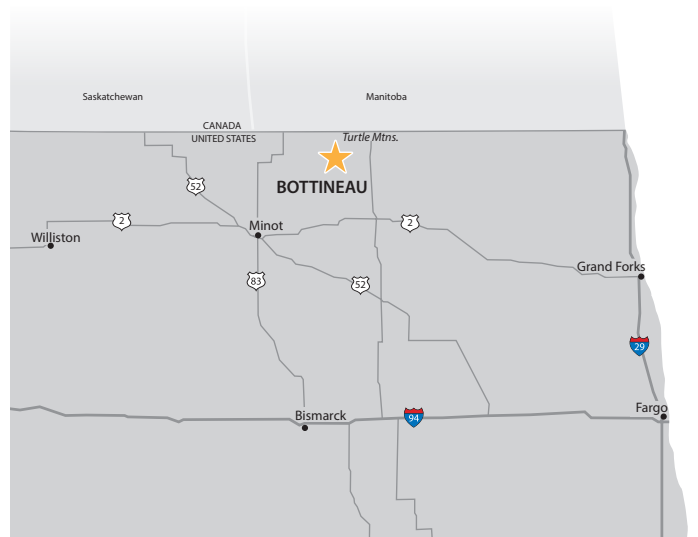
