The LEAP Program

Start small...go far with Dakota College at Bottineau.

The LEAP (Leading to Education and Advanced Preparation) program is available to dual credit/early entry high school students. Students must have approval from their high school administrator. By completing the LEAP program, students will receive a Certificate in College Studies alongside their high school diploma.

Benefits

- Time Savings — Students will save a year of college coursework
- Cost Savings — Only \$122.84/credit (students that qualify for the Bank of ND Scholarship can receive free tuition for two classes per year)
- Flexible Delivery — Students can take this program completely online or through a combination of online, face-to-face and ITV delivery
- Transferability — The general education courses in this program will transfer to other colleges in the North Dakota University System
- College Advisor — Assistance in developing individualized academic plan

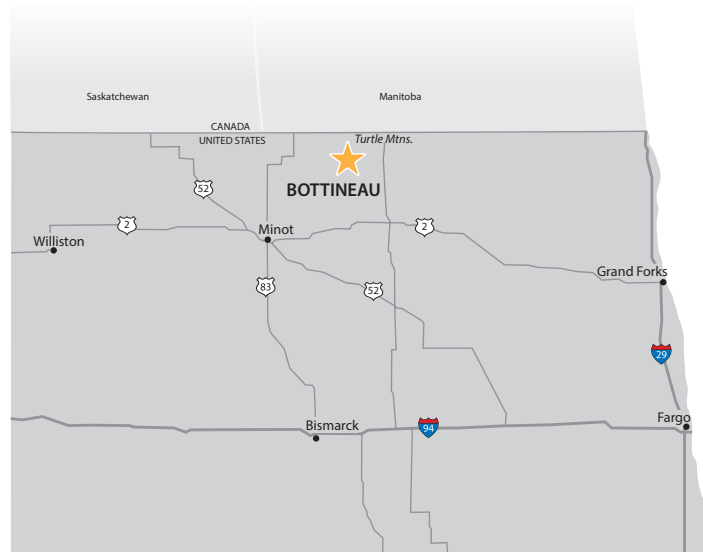
