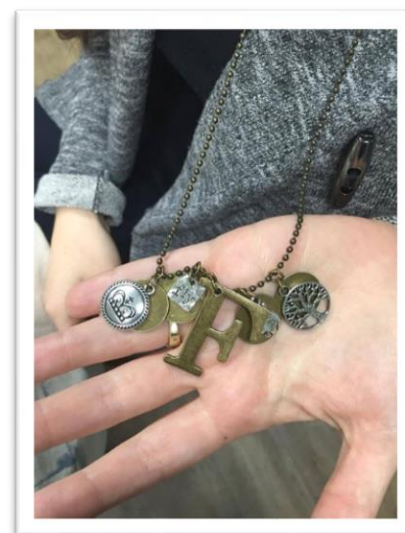


JEWELRY STAMPING CLASS
