



- As you can see in the graphic, there are a variety of tabs that you may choose from. If you would like to search for books and other materials in the library collection, click the **Find Books** tab.



Next, click **ODIN**. This is Dakota College at Bottineau Library's catalog. It allows access to books and other materials such as audio/visual items owned by our library and many other libraries statewide.

- Below is a screen shot of the PRIMO search page. This is where you will begin. Note: While you can use this option to check availability, you still need to come to the library to pick up any items that you wish to check out.



Enter your search term in the search bar. As you can see there is a drop down menu which gives you the option to search for material by type, (books, articles, etc.) as well as by location.

The headings on the left under **Refine my Results** will help you to narrow and focus your search. Notice the green circle indicating that the material is available, as well as the icon by each entry that tells what type of material it is (book, magazine, etc.).

The call number includes the Dewey Decimal number and the Cutter number. This is how you find the book among the library stacks. If you need any assistance locating materials the library staff is happy to help you!

Call Number

You can check out items from DCB library as well as the Bottineau Public Library and other libraries in the state. If you would like to check out materials from another library you will need to do an Inter-library Loan (ILL).

Should you ever need them, here are ILL instructions:

Step One: Select the item you wish to order from another library.

Step Two: Click on the “Request” icon and login using your EMPL # (without the “W”) and your last name.

Step Three: After you have logged into your ODIN Account, Change the “Not Needed After” date to 30 days from today’s date. (Example: if the date shows 08/21/2013 – change it to 09/21/2013) and click on the “Request” icon. This is the most important step! See the screen shot below to confirm what it should look like.

Online Library Resources

The on-line resources available to Dakota College at Bottineau patrons provide literally millions of items such as magazine, journal, newspaper, and reference citations - many of which are full-text articles. These links are to paid subscription databases, thus the content is reliable.

Instructions for Remote Access:

To access these databases from an off-campus site, you will be required to login. For students, please use your 7-digit EMPL number (without the "w"). Your password is your last name.

Example:
 Login: 1234567
 Password: smith (not case sensitive)

Other patrons should use their 14-digit barcode assigned by the library.
 Login: 2312200012345
 Password: smith

Anyone who has problems with access, please email the librarian. If you don't know your EMPL # or your patron barcode, we can look it up for you.



EBSCO...a great place to begin your research!

Once on the EBSCO site be certain to always select Full Text to be sure that you get the entire article you are seeking.



Begin searching! **Just a reminder:** If you are accessing materials off-campus, at some point you will be asked to log in. Your log in information is:

Username: This is your student number or EMPL ID. Enter the number only...not the "W". You can find this number on your student ID.

Your password is your last name. Ex: **Password:** Albertson (not case-sensitive)

As you can see, in addition to EBSCO, there are many other databases available to you. Browse through them when looking for information. Always remember to select Full Text when searching, otherwise you may only gain access to abstracts of articles rather than the entire thing.
