### **Purpose Statement**

The LEAP (Leading to Education and Advanced Preparation) and LEAP Beyond programs are available to dual credit/early entry high school students. Students must have approval from their high school administrator. By completing the LEAP program, students receive a Certificate in College Studies. By completing the LEAP Beyond program, students will receive either an Associate in Science or an Associate in Arts degree.

Students complete anywhere between 24-62 credits in the LEAP programs. The time and financial commitment will sometimes require students to take coursework during the summer semester. To continue providing equitable access, DCB offers the opportunity to enroll in courses required for degree completion during the immediate summer semester following graduation.

### **Policy**

Any early entry/dual credit student enrolled in the LEAP or LEAP Beyond program can enroll in DCB courses offered the immediate summer semester following their final high school semester to meet the completion requirements of the LEAP or LEAP Beyond degree.

If a student enrolls while they are still in high school, they are considered a high school student for registration purposes. Leap students will receive the discounted tuition rate as set by the North Dakota University System (NDUS) for the remaining summer courses required for degree completion.

LEAP students receiving the dual credit rate for summer classes, following their final high school semester, are not eligible to receive financial aid.
