This letter indicates that an income tax return was not filed for 2022. If a nontax filer attempted and was not able to obtain the verification of non-filing letter from the IRS, the nontax filer may provide the signed statement below.

Forms must be turned in 45 days before the end of fall/spring semester and 20 days before the end of summer semester.
