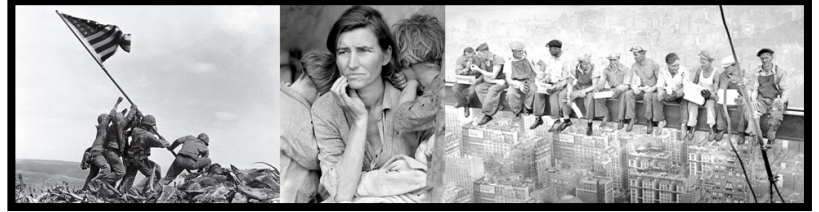


IMAGES THAT SHAPED AMERICA

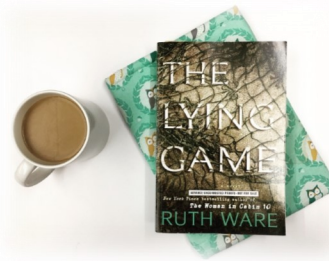
